1. Create a Child Account

- Use your child's real birth year so Roblox applies proper agebased restrictions.

2. • Enable Account Restrictions (Parental Controls)

- Go to Settings (gear icon top-right)
- Select Parental Controls
- Toggle Account Restrictions to On
- Create a Parent PIN to lock settings
- 3. O Manage Chat Settings
- Go to Settings > Privacy

Adjust the following:

- Who can message me?
- Who can chat with me in-app?
- Who can chat with me in-game?

Recommended: Set all to Friends or No one

4. **(a)** Monitor Activity

- Log into your child's account to check:
 - Friends list (delete and block any unknown)
 - Games played
 - Messages and chats
 - Purchase history
 - Private servers joined (this could be a sign of interacting with strangers).

- Never share passwords or personal information
- Avoid users offering free Robux or external links
- Report bullying, inappropriate games, or messages

6. 👗 Set Screen Time Limits

- Roblox's in-app timer (if available)
- Apple Screen Time (iOS)
- Google Family Link (Android)
- Parental control apps like Qustodio

7. 🧾 Use the Parent PIN

- Go to Settings > Parental Controls
- Create or update the Parent PIN
- Ensure your child does not know the PIN

Quick Safety Checklist

- Real Birth Year Used $\rightarrow \checkmark$ Yes
- Account Restrictions \rightarrow \bigtriangledown On
- Chat Settings $\rightarrow \bigcirc$ Friends or No one
- Parent PIN $\rightarrow \bigcirc$ Enabled
- Activity Monitoring \rightarrow \bigcirc Weekly
- Teach Scam Awareness \rightarrow \bigcirc Ongoing
- Screen Time Limit $\rightarrow \boxdot$ 1 hour/day (recommended)
